### NUTRITION EDUCATION

#### Teaching About Healthy Eating and Active Living.

At Colby Elementary School in Clark County, FoodWise taught a five-lesson series in all 1st grade classrooms. Lessons focused on the MyPlate food groups, trying new foods multiple times, and the importance of physical activity. Students tasted hummus with jicama, tried smoothies made with vegetables, created their own plant part diagrams, and made a healthy whole grain snack. They learned how to pronounce foods in English and Spanish, make healthy choices in each food group and could identify healthier options in every group.
