STRAWBERRY AND WHITE CORN SALAD

INGREDIENTS

- 4 ears fresh white sweet corn
- 1 pint fresh strawberries
- 1/2 cup fresh basil
- 2 tablespoons sunflower oil
- 1/4 cup white balsamic vinegar
- 1 tablespoon poppy seeds
- 1 teaspoon white pepper

Recipe from Original Local!

1. Into a large bowl, cut kernels from the cobs, tossing to break apart.
2. Stir in strawberries and basil.
3. In a small bowl, whisk oil, balsamic, poppy seeds, and pepper until well combined.
4. Toss corn, strawberries, and basil with dressing and serve immediately.
